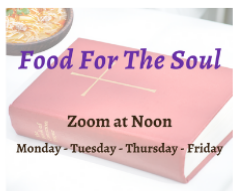

Come join us for fellowship, fun, and pancakes on Shrove Tuesday, March 1st from 6:00-8:00pm in Shepherd's Hall.

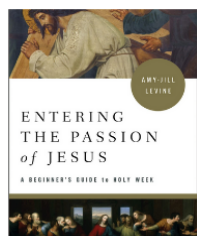
No tickets required, and the EYC will accept donations at the event. EYC members, please save the date to help. If you are an adult interested in helping, please contact Karen Boyne.

## Adult Sunday Formation

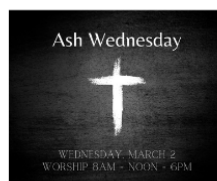
Let us journey together as we delve into the stories in the four Gospels recounting the last week of Jesus' life - stories that are at the heart of the Christian experience, and provide

You are invited to worship with us in person at CGS at:

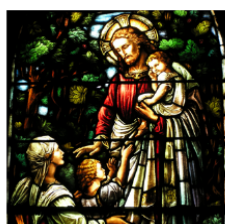
8:00am, Noon, and 6:00pm (this service also livestreamed).
