What is Stewardship?

The definition of Christian stewardship is a follower of the teachings of Jesus Christ spending their time, money, and energy focusing on making the world better and taking care of the people and things which are important to them.

An example of Christian stewardship is making regular donations to the church to which you belong.

The free gift of God's grace shapes our faith and leads to the conviction that all we have (in the way of time, talent, treasure, and testimony) are things that we have been given for a purpose. We cannot separate our acceptance of God's grace from the practice of generosity.

Stewardship is an opportunity to witness to the reckless nature of God who gives the free gift of salvation by grace to all who will receive it. Generosity is the fullest expression of the life of a steward, one who has been given a gift, a gift that must be used wisely and for a purpose.
